Since you live in Horsens Municipality, we are able to offer you Danish lessons.

The Danish language programme is voluntary and is valid for 5 years from the date of referral.

What is the Danish language programme all about?

The Danish language programme provides you Danish lessons, which take place at the language centre. There are daytime, evening and Saturday classes. In some cases, there is the option of online teaching, or a combination of physical and online teaching.

You will be offered a programme that corresponds to your qualifications in your home country. You will start at the level in Danish that suits you.

The Danish language programme is divided into up to 6 modules. Each module concludes with a test, which a student must pass within a set time frame. The programme concludes with a written and an oral exam.

The table below shows how long you have in terms of passing the different modules.

If you wish to start at a later point

The offer of Danish lessons is valid for 5 years from the date of referral. Therefore, you do not have to start right away.

If you would like to your classes to take place at a different language centre

As a rule, you will be enrolled in a Danish programme at Sprogcenter Midt in Horsens.

You also have the option of attending another language centre. In that case, it is important to contact Horsens Job Centre and inform them of where you would prefer to start your programme.

Deposit

The Danish language programme is paid for by Horsens Municipality.

Before you can start the Danish programme, you must pay the language centre a deposit of DKK 2,000. The language centre can inform you about a refund of the deposit.

If you are an au-pair, you do not have to pay a deposit.
