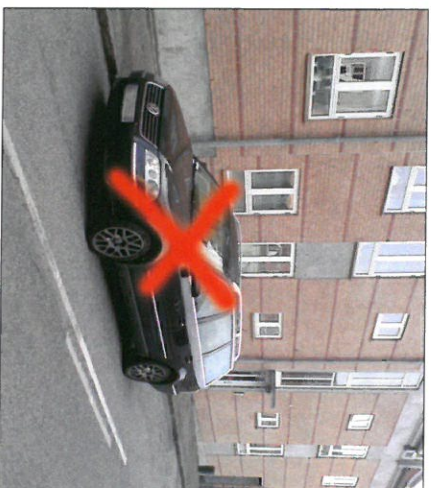


## Parking bays on parking ground



At parking grounds with parking bays it's not allowed to park the car other places that in the parking bays.

## Carriageway lines



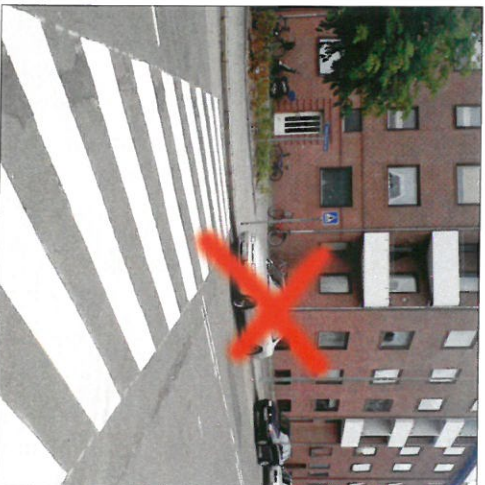
Do not stop or park where there are less than 3 m between your vehicle and a single or double continuous white line marking a traffic lane with no broken white line between your vehicle and the continuous white line. A carriageway line is a continuous white line.

## Traffic lanes



Do not stop or park along a stretch of road approaching an intersection where traffic divided into lanes by lines painted on the carriageway or within 5 m of where the lanes markings starts.

## Pedestrian crossings



Do not stop or park on a pedestrian crossing or 5 m before a pedestrian crossing (in direction you are driving).

## Parking in front of driveways and gates



No parking in front of driveways and gates where there is a asphalt ramp or lowered curb.

## Parking fines and appeals



Both Danish an foreign-registered cars get immediately a giro on DK 510,00 – they must pay by giro in bank or Post Office. If you wish to dispute a fine an appeal can be made to [teknikogmiljo@horsens.dk](mailto:teknikogmiljo@horsens.dk)

Appeals are dealt with in accordance to the Danish Code of Parking Regulations. (Færdselsloven §§ 28 - 29). The fact that you parked in good faith or don't know the Danish rules will not exempt you from the fine.

## Good advice

Always park on the right side of the road and in the direction you are driving.

Always carry coins for the automatic ticket machines, so you don't get a fine, while you are walking after coins.

No discount for students or other groups.

Be aware of parking signs and street marking when parking your car. Don't be fooled by the illegal parking of other motorists.

With this small p-guide in your hand, you can very quickly see the most important parking rules



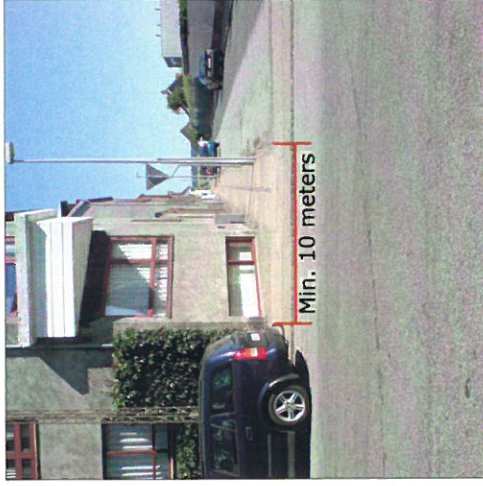

## Parking zones



1. P: Parking zone. Look for additional signs on how to park.
2. Indicates a pedestrian zone where no parking is allowed. There is an exception for the specially marked parking spaces found on Søndergade.

## 10 meter rule



Do not park or stop your vehicle at an intersection or within 10 m of the nearest curb of an intersection or bike path.

## Bike paths



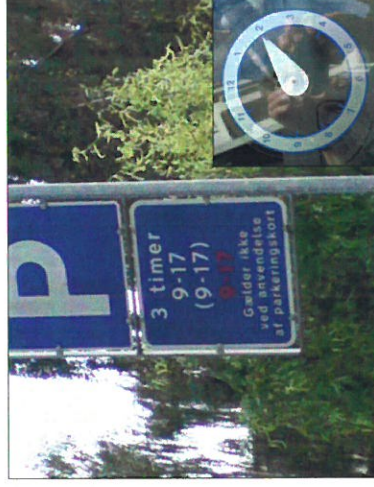
1. Stopping or parking with any part of the vehicles on a bike path is forbidden.
2. Do not park or stop on or within 5 m of an exit from a bike path, but you can park on the other side of the exit.

## Parking on sidewalk



All parking on pavements is banned partly throughout the municipality. In some streets there are exceptionally plate with the partial parking is allowed.

## Time-restricted parking



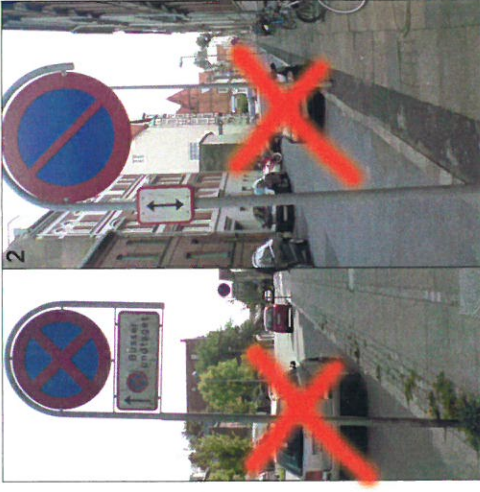
Many parking lots have time limited parking. Use a parking disc in the front window of your car to indicate your arrival time. When parking before a time limit starts you are allowed to set the parking disc to the actual start of the time limit. Parking discs must be intact.

## Parking tickets



Parking tickets are required, when parking your car in Horsens during the hours of 9-17 Monday – Friday and (9-13 Saturday). Look for green automatic ticket machines at the parking lots. Parking tickets are valid on all of Horsens Municipality's parking lots.

## No stopping / No parking



1. Do not stop or park.
2. No parking allowed except when dropping off or picking up passengers (3 min. max.).

## Busstop and yellow lines



No stopping or parking within 12 meters of a bus stop. No stopping or parking in bus bays.
